Ontario Prime Minister Doug Ford announced that with vaccination 85% of the province's population with one dose and 75% of the population with two doses, all Covid19 restrictions will be lifted. No masks, no social distancing, no gathering restrictions inside and outside and no travel restrictions. As if we're back to the fall of 2019. this is a much higher standard than the UK standard for removing all restrictions and hopefully it'll take less risk to community health as it is.

But when will this standard be achieved? If other provinces of Canada want to meet the same standard, Quebec and Nova Scotia should remove all restrictions by next week. These two provinces have vaccinated about 83% of their population with one dose and have no hard work to turn it into 85 Ontario has vaccinated 80% of its population so far, and to reach that standard, it needs to vaccinate another 5% of the population with one dose. With the current speed of vaccination, almost a percentage will be added to the first dose a week. That means Ontario will probably have to wait until fall arrives for conditions to return to fall 2019 What can accelerate this issue is the speed up of the first dose vaccination. For example, Mr. Stefan Harmon, who was anti-vaccines for a long time, even until the last day he went under the ventilator, said that these are all games. He went under the ventilator and didn't come out alive a few hours after this " game
